Secretary's Report

INTRODUCTION

This paper informs Members of the activities undertaken by the Women's Commission (WoC) and the Women's Division since the 28th meeting held on 9 June 2005.

ACTIVITIES HELD SINCE THE LAST MEETING

2. The activities held since the last meeting are as follows-

- 18 June 2005 : Six Members of the Women's Commission together with staff members of the Women's Division visited the North District and met local women personalities and representatives of local women's groups to exchange views on a wide range of women issues.
- 30 June 2005 : The Women's Commission and the Community Investment and Inclusion Fund Committee jointly organized a workshop on "How Women Groups Lead the Development of Social Capital and Community Building" to promote exchange of experience between women groups in empowerment of women and development of social capital. Over 60 participants attended.
- 5 July 2005 : Seven Members of the Women's Commission and staff members of the Women's Division met with 12 representatives of the Hong Kong Women's Coalition on Equal Opportunities to exchange views on various women issues.

- 21 July 2005 : The final and cum prize presenting ceremony of the Orientation Game Design Contest to promote gender awareness (全港大專生性別認知迎新遊戲設計比賽) jointly organized by the Women's Commission and the Equal Opportunities Commission was held. Five finalist teams demonstrated their design for the adjudicating panel and fellow students. The Champion went to a team from the Hong Kong Polytechnics University.
- 23 July 2005 : Chairperson and three Members of the Women's Commission together with the Women's Division visited the Kowloon City District and met local women personalities and representatives of local women's groups to exchange views on various women issues.
