INTRODUCTION

This paper informs Members of the activities undertaken by the Women's Commission (WoC) and the Women's Division since the 30th meeting held on 13 October 2005.

ACTIVITIES HELD SINCE THE LAST MEETING

2. The activities held since the last meeting are as follows-

organised by the Hong Kong Council of Social Service. Also present at the conference as a keynote speaker was the Commission of Police.

• 26 November 2005

Chairperson and the Convenor of the Working Group on Gender Mainstreaming Women's Commission and Prof. Fanny Cheung, Director, Gender Research Centre of the Chinese University of Hong Kong cum Member of the Women's Commission delivered talks at a seminar on gender mainstreaming organised by the Health, Welfare and Food Bureau for Members of the Legislative Council (LegCo). Two Members of the Commission also attended. Two LegCo Members and representatives of three LegCo Members participated.

• 26 November 2005

Four Members of the Women's Commission together with staff members of the Women's Division visited the Yuen Long District and met local women personalities and representatives of local women's groups to exchange views on a wide range of women issues.

Ms Joanna Lau, Member of the Working Group on Safety of the Women's Commission, attended the opening ceremony of Social Welfare Department's community-based awareness raising courses on domestic violence (「社區同心,齊抗暴力」認識家庭暴力訓練課程)as one of the guests of honour.

• 3 December 2005

Chairperson of the Women's Commission officiated at the opening ceremony of the Chinese Women Forum (華人婦女論壇) organised by the Hong Kong Young Women Christian Association.
