WOMEN'S COMMISSION Secretary's Report

INTRODUCTION

This paper informs Members of the activities undertaken by the Women's Commission (WoC) and Welfare Team 2 of the Labour and Welfare Bureau (LWB) since the 53rd meeting held on 31 March 2009.

ACTIVITIES HELD SINCE THE LAST MEETING

- 2. The activities held since the last meeting are as follows -
 - 7 April 2009 : Mr Pham Cao Phong, Consul General of Vietnam, paid a courtesy call to the WoC Chairperson, and he was met by the Chairperson and AS(Welfare)2A.

The WoC Chairperson and Dr Yeung Ka-ching attended the meeting of Kwun Tong District Council to introduce the various initiatives of WoC and explore opportunities for collaboration. PAS(Welfare)2 and AS(Welfare)2B also attended.

- 17 April 2009 : The Chairperson and a WoC Member Dr Leung Lai-ching attended the seminar on "Gender Equality and Gender Respect Media and Societal Culture, Where Do We Go from Here?" jointly organised by WoC and the Equal Opportunities Commission to officiate and give a closing remark respectively. PAS(Welfare)2, AS(Welfare)2B and RPO(Welfare)2 also attended.
- 25 April 2009 : The WoC Chairperson officiated at the *Family Health Month 2009* organised by the Hong Kong Federation of Women.

The WoC Chairperson officiated and gave a speech at the 24th Anniversary cum Inauguration Ceremony of the 10th Central Executive Committee of Yin Ngai Central Council.

• 26 April 2009: The WoC Chairperson officiated at the award presentation ceremony of "我的快樂家庭攝影比賽" organised by the Family Affairs Committee of the Democratic Alliance for the Betterment and Progress of Hong Kong, and participated in a panel discussion.

• 27 April 2009 : The WoC Chairperson attended a cocktail reception organised by the Consulate General of the Republic of South Africa to celebrate its National Freedom Day.

• 28 April 2009 : The WoC Chairperson and six WoC Members ¹ convened two exchange sessions with a total of 31 women's groups and related organisations to seek their views on the tentative programme of the WoC Conference and the format of the pre-conference event. PAS(Welfare)2, AS(Welfare)2A, SEO(Welfare)2, PPO(Welfare)2 and RPO(Welfare)2 also attended.

• 29 April 2009: The WoC Chairperson and two WoC Members² met with 16 representatives of the Hong Kong Women's Coalition on Equal Opportunities³ to exchange views on women issues. AS(Welfare)2A and AS(Welfare)2B also attended.
