Gerontechnology Platform

This paper briefs Members on the Gerontechnology Platform funded by the Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Fund (SIE Fund).

- 2. The Chief Executive announced in the 2020 Policy Address Supplement "Design, develop and operate an 'Gerontechnology Platform' Social under the Innovation Entrepreneurship Development Fund to link up different stakeholders on the supply and demand sides and enhance synergy by way of engagement, cross-sector partnership and collaboration." The Gerontechnology Platform comprises four basic functionalities, namely (1) a knowledge hub; (2) network and capacity building; (3) consultancy, localisation and testing support; and (4) impact assessment.
- 3. In 2020, the SIE Fund has appointed a collaborative coalition of ten organisations led by The Hong Kong Council of Social Service1 to design, develop and operate an inclusive one-stop Gerontechnology Platform, with the aim of fostering the development and application of gerontechnology to enhance the well-being, quality of life, independence and self-reliance of the elderly as well as provide support to their families, caregivers, healthcare staff and institutions, particularly under the "new normal". The project has commenced in January 2021 and will last for three years.
- 4. A brief introduction on the SIE Fund and the latest development of the project are set out in the Power-point presentation materials at **Annex**.

Gerontechnology products and services may very often be applied to rehabilitation and cater for the needs of people with disabilities.






4.3.8 Full-time Home-makers by Sex
